#### **Community Kits**

are assembled by JLKCMO members containing basic needed items to ease new residents' transitions from abusive situations.

#### Healthy U Family Meals

program works to address food insecurity and nutrition by providing grocery donations, healthy recipes and cooking instruction to participating families.

#### Community Resource Fair

provides free resources to the KC community at large. Open to the public, resources include health screenings, housing and financial resources.



#### Community Volunteers & Grants (CV&G)
